



Wet Empire Talent

Quick Start Guide

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Use this before a booking, in the car, or as the pinned Signal-group version.

Mindset

Rested. Fed. Sober. Prepared. Money-minded. You are hired entertainment, not a party guest. Stay focused on selling, protecting yourself, and leaving with your money.

Before You Leave

Contact the party contact. Confirm timing, address, surprise or not, number of guests, music setup, chairs without arms, garbage can, dim lights, food, and space to work. Tell them to make sure the boys bring money.

Pack

Work outfit, tall socks, safe shoes, blanket, knee pads, speaker, chargers, music connectors, baby wipes, water, snacks, toiletries, lipstick, hair elastics, warm clothes, shooters, and any approved show items you use.

Arrival Sequence

Arrive smiling and on time. Say hello. Ask for the bathroom. Square starting payment before changing. Secure your bag. Ask for chairs, garbage can, dim lights, and clear space. Park so you can drive out easily.

Opening Sequence

Music on. Walk out. Turn music down. Introduce yourselves. Put the attention on the entertainers. Announce shooters and price. Ask: Who's buying the first shooter? Then: Who's next?

Program Order

1. Shooters first. 2. Show or show upgrade. 3. Money game. 4. Lap dances. 5. Private dances and final upsells later. Follow the program every party.

Pricing Reminders

Shooters: \$20 each. Lap dances: \$40 and up per song. Private dances: \$60 and up per song. Girl-on-girl upgrade: \$300 per dancer minimum. Higher-level toy show: \$500 per dancer minimum. Money first every time.

Shooter Hustle

Buy the shooter cups before you need them. Prepare them before you leave. Dilute Sour Puss heavily with water. Do not use hard liquor. Make eye contact, point, smile, and ask: Who's next?

Partnership Rules

Agree on money splitting before the party. Do not sell a partner into anything she has not agreed to. Stay sober together. Be fair, respectful, helpful, and professional.

Travel Essentials

Do not be scared of remote bookings. Some of the biggest opportunities are the farthest away. Pre-make a bed in your car with a foamy, sheet, pillow, blanket, water, snacks, baby wipes, toothbrush, toothpaste, charger, warm clothes, and extra socks.

Core Principles

Get paid first. Keep money on your body. No tabs unless prepaid. Do not drink with customers. Hold boundaries early. Leave if you feel unsafe. Do not let the money flow die while money is still in the room. Come home with pure profit.

Packing Checklist

Work outfit, tall socks, safe shoes | Baby wipes, water, snacks | Toothbrush, toothpaste, toiletries | Speaker, charger, music connectors | Shooter cups with lids, prepared shooters | Blanket and knee pads | Warm clothes, extra socks | Foamy or car bed

setup for remote parties | Cash holder, garter, boots, or secure place on body | Prepared playlists: sexy country, high-energy, sexy R&B;/hip-hop



Final reminder: money first, stay sober, keep selling, protect your boundaries, sleep when you are tired, and come home with pure profit.
